## CLASS U RULES

Standard Class Rules apply and;

Exhibits must be delivered by 7:30pm Thursday

Wool may be left in containers so please write your name neatly and state which section you are exhibiting in.

An exhibitor may enter any number of fleeces but each fleece may be entered in one section only.

Ram's fleeces and fleeces from sheep that have been housed or rugged are ineligible.

Local section restricted to bona-fide farmers residing within 40 kilometres of Temora, cultivating not less than 40 hectares of cereals.

All wool to be of current seasons shearing and not more than 13 months growth.

All exhibits to be skirted.

Fleeces to be grown by exhibitor who may be required to make a statutory declaration to this effect.

Exhibits cannot be removed before 6pm Saturday.

## SECTIONS

All fleeces will be judged on the following scale of points:

### **OPEN SECTION**

1. Merino, fine wool fleece.
2. Merino, medium wool fleece.
3. Merino, strong wool fleece.

### **LOCAL SECTION**

4. Merino, fine wool fleece.
5. Merino, medium wool fleece.
6. Merino, strong wool fleece.

### **CROSSBRED SECTION** (Irrespective of Breed)

7. Comeback, 58-64.
8. Fine and Medium XB's 56's.
9. Strong XB's 50's down.

## **HOW TO ENTER**

Fill out & sign the relevant entry form for each class entered. Forms are located in the schedule or can be downloaded from [www.temorashow.com.au](http://www.temorashow.com.au) or the Temora Show Facebook page. Entry forms and pavilion exhibits can be dropped to **155 Twynam St, Temora** 13th - 17th September from 12pm -7 pm and to the **Agricultural Pavilion** on Monday 20th to Wednesday 22nd September from 12pm -7 pm. Exhibits ONLY - Thursday 23rd September 7:30am - 7:30 pm. **CLOSED FOR JUDGING FRIDAY**  
Retain your entry tickets for safe and timely collection of exhibits. Check closing times for each pavilion class carefully

## **STANDARD CLASS RULES**

Written entries close 12pm Wednesday prior to the show. Limit of 2 entries per person, for each section of each class. Please read each section carefully. No exhibits to be removed prior to 6PM. Late entries may be accepted at the pavilion co-ordinators discretion. Pavilion will close promptly at Saturday 6PM and re-open 6:30pm for collection of exhibits.  
Entry fees: 50c per entry up to 10 entries, capped at \$5 thereafter

## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

All care will be taken of exhibits, but no responsibility will be held by the Temora Show Society, its members or volunteers. The committee shall not be responsible for any damage or loss to exhibits, any accident that may be caused through, or by, an exhibit and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the committee harmless and indemnified against any legal proceedings arising from any action, loss or damage for non-delivery of any exhibit. All decisions of the judges are final. Exhibitors must follow the requests of the stewards at all times. Only stewards, committee & judges are allowed in the pavilion during judging. The committee & stewards reserve the right to reject or remove any exhibit and will give a reason for doing so. Exhibit collection will be available from 6:30pm to 7:30pm on show day. You must present your entry ticket to the section steward who will assist you with the process and mark your exhibits as returned. The pavilion will also be open on Sunday after show day between 12pm – 2pm.  
Prize money can be collected on show day at the secretary's office from 1pm – 3pm on show day. Any money not collected by 31<sup>st</sup> October will be forfeited. Your generosity will assist in the running costs of the show.
